

Nomination & Election for Meece Middle School SBDM Parent Member

Meece Middle School PTA will be taking nominations through May 11, 2022, for one parent to serve a two-year term (July 2022-June 2024) on the School Based Decision Making (SBDM) Council.

About the Council

The council is the governing body for this school. Two parents, three teachers and the principal serve on the council. It decides school policy for curriculum, staffing, discipline, scheduling, instructional practices, extracurricular activities and other matters pertinent to the operation of the school. The council meets monthly on Tuesdays at 3:30 pm in the Meece Middle School Library.

For new SBDM parent members, there will be a 6-hour mandatory training. For anyone who has had SBDM experience, there will be a 3-hour mandatory training.

Nomination Process

Nomination forms are available on the school's webpage or can be picked up in the school's front office. Turn in the completed form to the school's front office by the end of school on May 11, 2022. Parents may nominate themselves or another parent.

Nominees must be a parent, stepparent, foster parent or legal guardian of a student attending the school during the council member's term of office. Nominees may not be an employee or relative of an employee of the school or district administrative office, nor a member or spouse of a member of that school board.

Election

The election will be held on May 13, 2022, from 8:30 am – 3:30 pm at Meece Middle School. Parents of students who will attend Meece Middle School during the 2022-23 school year are eligible to vote.
