### I. Instruction (for Purple/ Gold Model)

1. Google Classroom will serve as our content delivery platform for both in school and distant learners.
2. Student who are Distant Learners all year will meet live with their teachers on Monday's and Fridays during their normal class time.
3. Purple (A) students will always be at school on Mondays and Wednesdays and Gold (B) students will always be at school on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
4. In school and distant learning students will both receive the same amount of instruction, the same lesson content and be held to the same academic expectations.
5. Students not in person will daily "check in attendance" through Infinite Campus Portal.
6. Teachers will post daily class material (instructional videos, resources, assignments, etc.) in their Google Classrooms.
7. This model provides students & families with structure, flexibility, support, & consistency needed to meet their learning needs.
8. This model provides teachers with adequate time to respond to student digital needs (grading assignments, offering feedback, etc.) as well as continue to develop new & engaging digital learning opportunities.

## **B. Movement/Expectations (when in-person)**

### **1. Before School (7:40 - 8:07)**

- a) All bus riders will be temperature checked upon boarding the bus and will enter MMS ONLY through the main front doors.
- b) All parent drop-off students will be temperature checked by staff when they arrive. If the student is at 100.4 or displays symptoms, they will have to leave with their parent or guardian. Once temperature is checked, these students will enter ONLY through the band doors.
- c) Any student with a temperature of 100.4 or above will receive a HIGH TEMPERATURE PARENT NOTICE sheet with instructions, date, and recorded temperature.
- d) Breakfast will be available. Students can pick up breakfast and eat in the cafeteria or designated areas.

### **2. During School (8:07-3:10)**

- a) After 8:07 am, students or guests will ONLY enter or exit through the front entrance of the school where they will be temperature checked.
- b) If temperature is above 100.4 F, student will be sent to designated area for re-check by nurse. The school nurse will check temperature and if still above 100.4, the guardian will be called to pick up the student and a HIGH TEMPERATURE PARENT NOTICE will be given.
- c) All students and staff must wear a mask anytime they are less than 6ft. from others.
- d) IF YOU MOVE, YOU MASK.
- e) WALK LIKE YOUR PARENTS DRIVE - stay to the right in the hallways, give proper social distancing when following someone.
- f) LUNCHTIME TRADITIONAL - Students will eat lunch in an assigned location in either the cafeteria or the gym. NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK CAN BE BROUGHT TO STUDENTS FOR THIS YEAR. Microwaves will not be available for this year either.
- g) LUNCHTIME VIRTUAL - Distance learners will have the option to pick up breakfast and lunch at the same time from the cafeteria or on Friday's at a designated location in Somerset.

## **C. Dismissal (2:50 to 3:15)**

1. Parent pick up students will be dismissed after 2:50 announcements and then move to designated dismissal areas. Parents must wait for a teacher to call their child's name (parents, please do not use your cell phone to call your child to come outside)

1. Students will be expected to check their school email daily and complete any assignments/ lessons.
