

Meece Middle Jr. Beta Club



Qualifications for Initial Membership:

1. GPA - Students must keep term grades at or above a “B” average.
2. Character - Students must have excellent character that reflects the morals of the National Beta Club – as evidenced by discipline records, and conduct grades. Students must have conduct grades that are at least a “B” or better and must have no disciplinary referrals to be inducted.
3. Dues - Pay a one-time \$15.00 National Beta Club fee, plus \$5 Meece Middle Jr. Beta Club fee. If you cannot pay this fee, please see Ms. Decker. *If you have already paid the \$15.00 National Beta Club fee in the past, you do not need to pay it again.*
4. Parent’s permission – Parent permission is required to participate in Jr. Beta.

Application Process:

1. Applications will be given to students who have met the GPA and conduct requirements at the end of the first nine week grading period. The application will need to be completed in order to determine the other areas of membership qualifications. Applications will be due **Wednesday, October 27th, 2021 during our Beta Club Meeting.**
2. Applicants must meet all the qualifications for membership.
3. **Bring your completed application and fees to our Beta Club Meeting on Wednesday, October 27th, 2021.**
4. Students selected for membership will be notified prior to the Beta Induction Ceremony.
5. Attend the Beta induction ceremony (date TBA).

Membership Requirements:

1. Students must keep term grades at or above a “B” average in any class to remain in Jr. Beta. Should the student’s grades fall below this criteria, they will be put on probation until the next grading period. If they do not meet the grade criteria a second time, they will no longer be in Beta.
2. Students must maintain excellent character and behavior. After the induction, should a student receive a conduct grade less than a “B” or receive a disciplinary referral, they will be put on probation. If it occurs a second time, they will no longer be in Beta. Depending on the severity of the behavior, sponsors and/or the principal have the discretion to remove students from the club at any time, should they deem it necessary.
3. Students must earn at least FIVE community service hours by the end of the school year. In order to remain in Jr. Beta, community service hour logs (attached) must be returned to Ms. Decker before the end of the school year. Some community service opportunities will be conducted during club meetings and sponsored by our Meece Middle Jr. Beta Club and FRYSC.
4. You are responsible for listening to announcements and communicating with the club sponsors for Beta information. Once accepted, Ms. Decker will send you an invitation to Meece Middle’s Jr. Beta Club Google Classroom in order to share information about upcoming events. Our meetings will be held in the cafeteria during club time.
