

**PROCEDURES, CONSISTENT WITH LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD POLICY,
FOR DETERMINING ALIGNMENT WITH STATE STANDARDS,
TECHNOLOGY UTILIZATION AND PROGRAM APPRAISAL POLICY KRS
160.345(2)(i)(10)**

PURPOSE:

The Procedures, Consistent with Local School Board Policy, for Determining Alignment with State Standards, Technology Utilization, and Program Appraisal Policy for Hopkins Elementary School ensures that all students have equitable opportunity to highly effective teaching practices at all levels and with all classes.

POLICY STATEMENT

The school council shall align all instruction and other activities with state standards established in state laws and regulations, and in a manner that is consistent with local school board policy. The school will utilize technology in a manner consistent with the local school board policy and state laws and regulations. The school shall appraise all programs in a manner that is consistent with the local school board policy. Programs shall be appraised upon the request of the school council by assigning the program appraisal to the appropriate committee for completion and recommendation to the council. Analyzing and disaggregating student performance data will be an ongoing process to identify curriculum gaps, strengths, and weaknesses. Ad-hoc committees and/or the principal will provide a report to the SBDM Council of the status of student performance as measured by the state assessment process, implementation/impact of the current continuous school improvement plan, and state of technology utilization.

Students and parents will be given an acceptable user policy including an internet use form, video/photograph agreement form, and a release of educational records form to sign. Teachers shall be cognizant of any student not given permission for any activity and shall provide the school office with a list of students and prohibited activities.
